ETC is committed to addressing the nation's transmission needs by developing new, state-of-the-art transmission lines to ensure power is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, wherever it is needed. ETC is entering a market in which U.S. companies are projected to spend \$60 billion to \$100 billion on transmission development projects by 2020.

New transmission projects will have a significant positive impact on the nation's energy future. ETC is focused on preparing for a high-growth, low-carbon future by supporting movement of renewable energy, improving system reliability, and reducing grid congestion, thereby improving the flow of electricity to our communities.
